Persons with mental or physical impairment should not be permitted on ride. This would include those under the influence of drugs or alcohol.	<u>x</u>		
No riders under the age of 3 years old, unless the unit is specifically designed for their use.	<u>x</u>		
No shoes, eyeglasses, jewelry, or sharp objects.	<u>x</u>		
No somersaults, diving, wrestling, flips, or rough play.	<u>X</u>		
No food, drinks, gum, pets, or silly string.	<u>x</u>		
Do not jump onto or off of the ride.	<u>x</u>		
Use of whistles or signaling devices is advised.	<u>X</u>		
Keep riders away from the blower at all times.			
Do not use inflatable device if wind conditions exceed 15mph or if it rains.	<u>x</u>		
Riders should go down slide feet first only, with no more than two riders at once.	<u>x</u>		
No climbing up the slide.	<u>x</u>		
No jumping onto the slide area.
